Consultations and Vaccines Available by Appointment

Travel consultations with our Travel Health Nurses include itineraryspecific health advice; discussion and administration of immunizations; safe food/water practices; and other recommendations, including insect precautions and environmental considerations.

- Hepatitis A & B
- Yellow Fever {we are a U.S. Government Certified Yellow Fever Center}
- Typhoid
- Rabies
- Japanese Encephalitis
- Polio
- Meningitis
- Measles {MMR}
- Preventative medication for:
 - o Malaria
 - Altitude Sickness
 - o Traveler's Diarrhea

We can also provide advice on ways to avoid the mosquitos that carry diseases such as:

- Zika virus
- Yellow fever
- Malaria
- Dengue fever
- Chikungunya
